Cities and Historical Sights:

The first and last nights will be at a country house hotel outside of London to facilitate transfer to and from the airport. On your journey through the south-west region of the United Kingdom, you'll have the opportunity to visit the homes of Jane Austen and Agatha Christie, spend time at the quaint fishing village of Padstow on the north coast of Cornwall, Truro, a cathedral city and Cornwall's only city and Dartmouth in Devon. You'll visit the ancient castle of Tintagel (the legendary home of King Arthur); Stonehenge; the Eden Project; the grand home and garden of Caerhays Castle; Rosemoor (an RHS garden); Glendurgan Gardens and, as a highlight, the Abbey Gardens of Tresco, which you'll access via helicopter. Your last visit is to Wisley, the mainstay- and trial garden of the Royal Horticultural Society, just outside London.

Monday, 13th May 2024 Flight departure from the US to London, Heathrow Airport

DAY 1 Arriving in London on Tuesday 14th May, 2024

DAY 2 – 4 Padstow, Cornwall

En-route to Cornwall, we'll visit Finch Foundry, a water-powered forge with a lovely cottage garden. The foundry was at one time a 19th-century family owned business, producing mining and farming tools to industries located in the South West of England. You'll dine at the hotel this evening.

DAY 3


We'll be travelling across to the east coast of Cornwall today to visit the Eden Project, created by transforming an almost 200 ft deep china clay pit into a global garden display, employing massive conservatories to house specific world biomes. The evening is at your leisure in Padstow.

DAY4

A visit to the Royal Horticultural Society garden of Rosemoor and lunch, then on to King Arthurs' Tintagel, to explore this ancient site. Your evening in Padstow is at your leisure.

DAY 5 – 7 Truro, Cornwall

An early departure from Padstow to board a helicopter for a short 15 minute hop from Penzance to the Isles of Scilly to visit the Tresco Abbey Gardens, a sub-tropical oasis home to some 20,000 plants from 80 countries.

DAY 6

The day out today is a visit to the stunning spring gardens at Caerhays, a coastal castle. In the afternoon, you'll be able to walk the quaint streets of one of Cornwall's traditional working harbor villages, Mevagissy. Your evening is at your leisure in Truro.

DAY 7

Glendurgan was created in the 1820's by Alfred and Sarah Fox, where they developed a garden with some rare and exotic plants, as well as a maze. They also built a small single room school for the local and their own children, of which they had 12. The property runs right down to a small beach on the river Durgan's edge. The evening is at your leisure in Truro.

DAY 8

Farewell to Cornwall today as we head back north to Devon and a visit to Agatha Christie's home Greenway House, situated on the banks of the tidal river Dart. After lunch, you'll have an opportunity to explore the castle and charming village of Totnes, ending the day with a lovely pub dinner on the river.
