EMERALD ISLE TOUR ITINERARY

Wednesday, 23rd August 2023

Flight departure from the US to Dublin, Republic of Ireland

The itinerary is based on an element of flexibility, taking into account any Covid-19 restrictions that may still be in place.

DAY 1 Arriving in Dublin on Thursday, August 24th, 2023

The Best Tours will meet you at Dublin International Airport for a three-night stay in Belfast at the Titanic Hotel, but on dry land, beside the original shipyards. This afternoon, you have an opportunity to join a guided tour of this historically troubled city, passing through once before “no go” areas to view the peace lines and a close-up view of the wall murals.

DAY 2 Northern Ireland

Your second day is a day of complete contrast from the city, with a visit to the natural beauty of the Giants Causeway (a world heritage site), the Carrick-a-Rede rope bridge Dunluce Castle and a tasting of Irish whiskey at Bush Mills Distillery.

DAY 3 Belfast

Today is a day in the city to visit the Titanic museum, which presents the fascinating story of this fabled and tragic ship and the glory of the city itself.

DAY 4 & 5 – The West Coast and Galway

A scenic drive across the island toward the west coast and Galway, but not without a stop first at the Stone-age Burial Mounds of Newgrange, another World Heritage site.

Your second day will be spent in the Burren, (place of stone) and a region of incredible interest - a vast limestone landscape almost resembling the moon and host to many ancient historic tombs. You'll experience a garden built from nothing to become award-winning with breathtaking views and an afternoon tea to remember.

DAY 6 & 7 – Kerry & the South-West

We move further South with a visit to the Cliffs of Mohr, then on to Limerick for lunch and Killarney for the next two nights. The evening is at your leisure to explore this delightful, small city.

Your second day in this area is spent taking in the magnificent views of the Ring of Kerry.

DAY 8, 9 and 10 - Dublin

An early departure from Killarney to visit Blarney Castle and then on to Dublin for the next three nights. An historic walking tour of the city, The Book of Kells at Trinity College or just strolling Grafton and O'Connell streets and exploring the city, are all available for you to enjoy, along with a Guinness or two of course!



Harrington Hall Hotel (3 nights)

DAY 11

An early departure from your Dublin hotel to the airport for your international flight to the USA.
