SOUTH AFRICAN SAFARI ITINERARY

Flight departure from the USA to Johannesburg.

DAY 1

Arrive at Johannesburg's OR Tambo International Airport. Transfer to your hotel.

DAY 2, 3 and 4

An early flight to the Elephant Coast of Kwa-Zulu Natal where your exclusive guest house for the next three days is situated in a private game reserve. You'll have the opportunity of visiting Hluhluwe Game Reserve home of the Rhino rehabilitation program and the St. Lucia Wetlands, South Africa's first World Heritage Site.

DAY 5

After breakfast a scenic drive north west to Mpumalanga will bring us into the Drakensberg range of mountains and the Panoramic Route. Your boutique guest house is nestled in the foothills of this grand landscape.

DAY 6

DESERTS AND DAISIES TOUR ITINERARY

Flight departure from the USA to Johannesburg International Airport.

DAY 1

Arrive at Johannesburg International Airport, transfer to your local hotel.

DAY 2 and 3

Transfer to Johannesburg International Airport for your flight to Windhoek, Namibia. Your drive from Windhoek south, to the dune area of Sossusvlei, takes you through dramatic countryside with exquisite vistas. Your 2-night stay in this land of orange, red, and pink sand dunes – the largest and oldest dunes in the world – will leave you with unforgettable memories.

DAY 4

We make our way to Swakopmund today with time for an afternoon activity exploring the surrounding area of this unique seaside town.

DAY 5

We travel north toward the Etosha National Park, and overnight at Erongo Wilnderness Lodge, situated in wilderness area and circled by the Erongo Mountains. Your luxury tented chalet is set amongst granite boulders and offers breathtaking views of the desert, mountain and bushveld.

DAYS 6, 7 and 8

The next three days are spent in Etosha itself (which are Malaria free), staying at the camps within the park, enabling us to explore the salt pans and the wildlife that is so abundant at this time of the year.

DAY9

We take leave of Etosha and head for Windhoek where you'll get the opportunity to visit the city and get some beautiful gifts from the region to take back home.

DAY 10

A quick flight from Windhoek to Cape Town and a short drive north will bring us into the Cederberg where you'll overnight in the small town of Clanwilliam in the heart of the "flower route".

DAY 11 and 12

Your stay for the next two nights is at a luxury eco camp only accessible by 4x4 vehicles, where you'll have an opportunity to take solitary strolls along the coastline to spot seals, birds and other wildlife and go on guided flower walks.

DAY 13 and 14

We return to Cape Town for the last two nights of your tour. Here you'll have the opportunity to see the sights of the Cape and partake in some of the best food and wine in the world
